**Learning outcomes:**  
The course is oriented towards gaining basic knowledge of transactions in corporate law, M&A with special emphasis on practical aspects, students should be able to write basic documents for corporate transactions, analyze points of contention and justify their own solutions. They should also be able to select an appropriate litigation strategy, justify its choice while evaluating the positives and negatives, estimate litigation risk and be able to articulate their conclusions appropriately. Through problem solving, students should deepen their critical thinking skills, as well as their ability to argue and present their own ideas, and the subsequent ability to communicate and adapt their communication style to the addressee of the text.

2. Shareholders’ agreements and arrangements in corporate documents.
3. Share purchase agreements: negotiation.
4. Share purchase agreements: liability, reps & warranties.
5. Corporate litigation 1: annulment of decisions of shareholders assembly.
6. Corporate litigation 2: liability claims.
7. Corporate litigation 3: M&A disputes, SPA.
8. Case studies.
