Final evaluation: The course is completed by a final evaluation - an examination in the form of an oral presentation of the doctoral student, in which he/she presents his/her own conclusions and attitudes to the solution of a partial legal problem assigned by the committee or in terms of normative or application practice of a current legal issue in the field of substantive or procedural civil law on the basis of a critical analysis and evaluation of existing doctrinal and jurisprudential approaches, or the use of comparative methods of scientific work. The doctoral student's presentation demonstrates a deeper systematic understanding of the field of study, a degree of familiarity with the current state of knowledge in the field, the ability to think independently in a creative analytical and synthetic manner with possible interdisciplinary overlap, mastery of the skills and methods of scientific research, as well as the ability to formulate one's own ideas, to draw conclusions from them, the ability to communicate and defend one's conclusions and to deal convincingly in scientific discourse with any opposing views or supplementary questions from members of the examination committee. The subject of the exam is current issues of current civil law legislation, current issues of application problems in judicial practice, as well as de lege ferenda considerations in terms of recodification of private law, with regard to the legislative process in the field of civil procedure. Civil law: General part, family law, right in rem, inheritance law, law of obligation. Civil procedure: Basic proceeding, enforcement proceeding, arbitration proceeding, bankruptcy and restructuring proceeding.
