Students are assessed on the basis of continuous evaluation - elaboration of a written assignment in the range of a maximum of 10 standard pages, in which the doctoral student gives an overview of the current state of knowledge for one of the dissertation (hypo)theses and at the same time polemically copes with this state of knowledge. By elaborating the assignment, the doctoral students demonstrate their ability to identify, classify and evaluate the relevant scholarly literature on a selected issue. At the same time, the doctoral students demonstrate the ability to think critically about scholarly texts of other authors in order to formulate new scientific hypotheses or normative theses.
