<b>Learning outcomes:</b>			
<p>The course builds on Mediation Clinic I. It briefly covers the legal regulation of mediation in both the Slovak and European contexts, but its main focus is on practicing practical skills and knowledge. Throughout the course, students actively participate in interactive exercises, thoroughly reviewing the mediation process, and also practice representing parties before a mediator.</p> <p>Upon completion, students should be able to identify a case suitable for mediation in practice and lead a simple simulated mediation. In eventum. The goal of the course is to identify a case suitable for mediation in practice, and write an invitation letter to the other party of the dispute. Mediation is defined as assisted structured negotiation of disputes. Its popularity is growing worldwide, and most significant legal systems today include some form of regulation. Mediation is globally used for seeking reconciliation in business, civil, labor, family, community, and other disputes.</p>

Practice – simulated mediations/case study focusing on neighborhood disputes/.</li> <li>5. Practice – simulated mediations/case study focusing on family mediation/.</li> <li>6. Practice – simulated mediations/case study focusing on labor disputes (or intellectual property disputes – depending on the students' year)/.</li> </ol>
