Method of evaluation: Completion by taking an examination					
Continuous evaluation: This part is implemented by completing 7 practical tests, which are focused on the perception and understanding of signing according to 3 thematic units (maximum 10 points for each test, minimum 5 points for each test). A condition for completing the subject is also the implementation of the non-contact part of the subject - self-study. This part is mainly realized by studying the recommended literature.					
Final evaluation: The requirement for the final assessment is the completion of an interim assessment and two practical outcomes: a) own 2-3 minute narration on a drawn topic (students draw a topic at the end of the week of the teaching part of the semester, work on it at home and send the video recording to the teacher at least three days before the exam date); maximum 10 points, minimum 5 points are to be obtained, b) A 15-minute conversation between the student and 3 tutors on topics assigned by the tutors (maximum of 20 points, minimum of 11 points to be earned). The total mark is the sum of the marks for all parts. A minimum of 91 points is required for an A grade, a minimum of 81 points for a B grade, a minimum of 71 points for a C grade, a minimum of 61 points for a D grade and a minimum of 51 points for an E grade.
