The draft of the final thesis shall be handed in to the lecturer at least 3 days before the examination date. This will be followed by an oral examination in which the student will justify the writing of the individual parts of the thesis, based on the knowledge gained by studying the content of the course. The submitted draft will be evaluated as follows: - Formal aspect - adherence to the current Guidelines (text layout - margins, text alignment, font type and format-10 points, error-free and stylistic text-10 points, graphic layout (headings, text itself, tables, graphs) - 10 points, total 30 points - Content of the text (explanation of concepts, logical coherence of the text - 20 points, citation and paraphrasing of the text, work with literature, method of citing literature after the text and in the list of literature used - 30 points, treatment of the methodology of the empirical part - 10 points, interpretation of the data obtained - 10 points) - 70 points in total. Learning outcomes: The student will be able to: LO1 explain the rules for writing a final thesis in terms of content and formal requirements, including the methods of citing references and bibliographic sources according to the current ISO standard, LO2 search for relevant professional and electronic information sources, assess the professional quality of processed publications, and appropriately paraphrase, cite, and interpret them, LO3 identify, analyse, and apply new knowledge from the humanities related to nursing care into nursing practice, LO4 prepare individual parts of the final thesis while adopting a critical approach to the obtained results and their possible application in practice, LO5 present the final thesis and apply the rules for the preparation and process of the thesis defence.
