Final evaluation: he subject ends with a final assessment, which consists of two parts: a) The student, according to the teacher's instructions, gradually processes the case, and at the end of the semester the teacher evaluates it and gives him feedback - a maximum of 50% of the total assessment. b) The student will be assigned the case management of "someone else's" work and his task will be to evaluate and comment on it - a maximum of 50% of the total evaluation. At least 95% is required to obtain an A grade, at least 89% is required to obtain a B grade, at least 83% is required to obtain a C grade, at least 77% is required to obtain a D grade, and an E grade is required obtain at least 71% of the total assessment.
