The student will be able to list the most important subjects of criminal proceedings and explain their roles, rights and obligations within criminal proceedings. The student will be able to explain in detail the requirements of an indictment and the procedural procedure for filing it, and at the same time will be able to formulate the indictment. The student will be able to describe the course of court proceedings with special emphasis on the course of the main hearing, while being able to list and explain the individual acts performed by the judge and prosecutor during the main hearing. The student will be able to use analytical thinking and, on this basis, evaluate the correctness of the procedure of the court and prosecutor in the context of a specific practical situation. In this regard, the student will be able to propose correct solutions and procedures that will be in accordance with the Criminal Code and the case law of the courts. The student will be able to develop a plan of procedure within the main hearing.					
Schedule of subject: 1. The essence of a crime - explanation of the basic features of the essence, analysis of individual features with an emphasis on the subjective side of the crime, explanation of individual features using practical examples and cases from application practice. 2. Sanctions - explanation of types, reference to the imposition of sanctions, conditions and consequences. 3. Detention with an emphasis on conditions, types, deadlines and decision-making. 4. Indictment and related actions. 5. Cross-section of the stages of criminal proceedings with an emphasis on proceedings before the court. 6. Decisions in criminal proceedings - types, conditions and significance.
