Continuous evaluation: Ongoing evaluation: the exam consists of two parts: - 25 % - preparation of the essay on the assigned topic. In the essay on the scope of one standard page (1 standard page includes 1,800 characters, including spaces), the student presents their own arguments on the given topic and the possibilities of its solution; - 75 % - The task of the written exam will be the elaboration of a practical example with one main question and 9 partial questions. Each question is evaluated by one point. The questions are related among each other and the student has the related legislation at their disposal. At least 6 out of 10 questions must be answered to successfully complete the final evaluation. Evaluation: A: 100-92; B: 91-84; C: 83-76; D: 75-68; E: 67-60; FX: less than 60 %.
