Learning outcomes: The aim of this subject is to acquaint students with the legislation of water ingenuity. Water is a vital raw material for which the value of environmental pollution and global warming is steadily rising. Students will acquire basic knowledge of water protection legislation. Part of the subject is the solution of practical cases concerning the use of water by different legal sectors. Within the subject, students also acquire basic knowledge about the sources of water care rights. As this is a very current legal issue, passing this subject will create prerequisites for the use of students in law firms, development and energy companies, state administration and self-government. Within the Slovak Republic, this is the first subject of this type taught at law faculties, which gives students a competitive advantage when applying to the labor market. After completing the subject, the student is able to: - understand the relationship between national, European and international law in the field of water care, - understand the basic rules on water management, - actively use the knowledge gained in the preparation of analysis, legal analysis and opinions in the field of building law, land law, cadastre of real estate, environmental law, energy law, - work independently with sources of law, professional and scientific literature for the purposes of processing bachelor's and master's theses.
