The assessment includes an ongoing evaluation during the semester, which includes case consultations with the clinic supervisor. Final evaluation: Completion by a continuing assessment Finished: By ongoing evaluation.					
Learning outcomes: Within the clinic, students will meet in the office of this clinic with persons raising legal problems, conduct an interview with them with an emphasis on recording the key points of their legal problems and then resolve the raised case under the supervision of a supervisor. The student will develop and strengthen their communication skills, empathy, learn to think in broader logical, but also multidisciplinary contexts within private and public law, based on which they will strengthen their analytical and synthetic skills in the field of law. The student will be able to apply legal regulation in relation to a specific problem. The student will be strengthened in their focus on the value-based solution of the case and the ethical side of the problem.
